Sign and return the enclosed documents:

1. International Speedway Inc. 2022 Membership Application with payment.
2. Sign Minor Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability.
3. Sign Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement.
4. "I Have Read and Understand this Release".
5. Sign the back gate sign-up sheet each week you wish to compete. Call International Speedway, Inc. by Monday at noon prior to the next Saturday's program.
6. If you sign-up for a program and cannot appear, please inform International Speedway, Inc. immediately.

Insurance and Gate:

1. International Speedway does **not** provide Riders with Medical Insurance coverage. **Racing is dangerous.** International Speedway, Inc. strongly suggests that each rider maintain his own Primary Medical Insurance coverage.
2. Ambulance services (e.g. Fire Department, Life Flight, non-contracted ambulance, etc.) are the responsibility of the injured party.
3. If you are injured you must report to the referee immediately.
4. **Rider Entry Pit Pass: \$30.00**
5. **Mechanic Entry Pit Pass: \$30.00**

Pit area

- Read your rule book!!!**
- See attached Junior Speedway Rules.
- Bikes are to be warmed up on the stand. No clutch starts, burn-outs or pit racing will be tolerated. **No pit racers!**
- Do not drain or throw away used motor oil in the pits.** Any rider or mechanic found to be dumping oil will be suspended from competition.
- Only licensed riders and mechanics that are signed-in for that night's program will be admitted to the pit area. In 2022 we will sweep the pits at 5:45pm. All un-credentialed guests will be asked to leave the pit area at that time. Competitors will park their vehicles just outside the pit area and unload their equipment. Guests will be asked to go to the grandstand area. Front gate opens at 6:00 pm.
- The pit gate is open from 5:00 - 6:00 only. From 6:00 - 10:00 the pit gate is closed. Participants are encouraged to stay after the races and sign autographs.
- No alcoholic beverages** permitted in the pit area at anytime!
- No race vehicles to be started before the riders meeting at 6:30 or after 10:00 pm.

Junior Speedway Recommendations Important Rules

- 1- **Engine Displacement: c.c.:** 250cc Junior riders must be approved by the event Promoter. 150cc Mini riders must use approved motorcycle.
- 2- **Tire size recommendation for 150cc Mini's:**
Rear: maximum 3.00-18
Front: maximum 2.75-21
We must make these bikes easy to ride and easy to slide.
- 3- **Riders age- 8-16:** We want to give everyone a chance to race but our insurance representative prefers the older kids. Junior riders must be approved by the event Promoter.
- 4- **Mufflers:** All mufflers must be approved, they must be mechanical and meet approved sound test.
- 5- **Fuel for Mini's:** Pump gasoline. NO RACE GAS. NO METHANOL
- 6- **Protective Gear:** All gear must be worn at all times to include but not limited to helmet, gloves, goggles, leathers, boots, knee pads, skid shoe and back protector. Gear must be in good condition and fit properly.
- 7- **Parent / Mechanic:** Must be present and be signed-in at back gate. Mechanics in pit area during event **must** wear black pants or team uniform and enclosed shoes.

International Speedway's first priority is to establish a Junior Speedway program which meets the following criterion:

- * Inexpensive and easily built and maintained machinery.
- * Close, attractive racing at relatively safe speeds.
- * Participation by as many new people as possible.
- * Make it simple, safe, cheap and easy and everyone can have fun!
